## **OPTIONS FOR VOTING**

### **VOTE BY MAIL**

- 1) If you received a mail ballot for the 2020 election, you are scheduled to receive a mail ballot for this special mayoral election
- 2) If you have signed up to vote by mail since the 2020 election you will receive a mail ballot for this special election
- 3) If you are not signed up to vote by mail, you can sign up until July 17

***TO CONFIRM*** you are scheduled to get a mail ballot for the Palm Coast Mayoral Election

***TO SIGN UP*** to get a vote by mail ballot

Call the Flagler County Elections office: (386) 313-4170 (through July 17)

- 4) Mail ballots will be start to be sent out on June 17.
- 5) Ways to return your mail ballot:
  - Fill it out, stamp it, and mail it immediately.
  - Drop off your ballot at the Elections Office Drop Box during office hours from 8:30 – 4:30 M-F or during Early Voting hours
  - Drop your ballot into a Drop Box at the Early Voting sites during Early Voting Hours or on Election Day

### **VOTE EARLY**

- 6) Flagler County Library, Palm Coast Community Center, Flagler Elections Office at the Gov't Bldg
- 7) Saturday, July 17 – Saturday, July 24
- 8) 10 am – 6 pm including week-ends
- 9) Vote in Person or drop off your Vote by Mail ballot at any of the locations

### **VOTE AT THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY**

- Vote in Person or drop off your Vote by Mail ballots at your polling place

- Vote at your normal precinct polling place unless you have been assigned a Temporary voting place
  - Precinct 8: **(Seminole Woods Voters)** Vote at the Flagler County Assoc of Realtors
  - Precinct 33: **(Marina Del Palma Voters)** Vote at Old King's Elementary School
